GOD WORKS IN YOU

God Began the Work

- Philippians 1:6 He began the work in the Philippians.
- The gospel preached at Philippi Acts 16:11-15, 30-34
- God began the work of salvation through the proclamation of His gospel Acts 16:9-10; Romans 10:13-17

GOD WORKS IN YOU

- God Continues the Work to Completion
 Philippians 1:6; 2:13 He will complete the work.
- Began with the gospel preached Romans 1:16; Acts 17:1-4 (Thessalonica)
- Work continued by God through the word 1 Thessalonians 2:13

Desire for Purpose

- Corinthians 5:14-15 no longer living for self, but for Christ.
- Christ's purpose revealed to us John 15:14-16
- His purpose becomes our purpose John 17:20-23

Desire to be Like Christ

- Corinthians 4:16 undergoing a process of transformation.
- We were attracted to Christ by His glory and virtue – 2 Peter 1:2-4 – we long to participate in such.
- The desire to be like Christ leads to purification according to God's will 1 John 2:2-3

Desire for a Better Life

1 Timothy 4:8 – promise for the life that now is.

- Necessities Matthew 6:31-34
- Health Romans 1:26-27; Proverbs 23:29-35; Romans 13:3-4; Proverbs 13:15

Family – Proverbs 24:3-4; Ephesians 5:22-33; 6:4

Desire for Hope

1 Timothy 4:8 – promise for the life that is to come.

Those who commit their lives to Christ can be confident He will keep them for their reward – 2 Timothy 1:12; 4:6-8

GOD WORKS IN YOU TO DO

The "will" naturally translates into the doing. However, the doing must be directed to "His good pleasure."

Not according to the flesh, but the Spirit – Galatians 5:16-26

Directed by the inspired word – 2 Timothy 3:16-17
